1. Post Graduate Teachers

(a) Mandatory Qualifications

- (i) A Masters Degree from any University recognised by the Govt of India/ UGC/ AICTE with a minimum aggregate marks of 50 percent in the subject and 50 percent in the aggregate:-

	PGT (History) :	A Masters Degree in HISOTRY from any University
	PGT (Geography) :	A Masters Degree in Geography from any University

Sub:- Amendment/Addition in the Affiliation Bye-Laws of the Board-reg.

Sir/Madam,

Consequent upon approval of the Affiliation Committee Meeting held on 14.01.2013 and subsequently ratified by the Governing Body of the Board in its Meeting held on 22.01.2013, I am directed to inform that the following amendments/additions in affiliation bye-laws of the Board have been made by the Board with the following modification:-

S No.	Existing Rule and provisions	Amended Rule
5	Rule 53.2. II (xvi) Physical Education Masters Degree in Physical Education from a recognized University.	Rule 53.2. II (xvi) PGT- Physical Education Master of Physical Education (MP.Ed.) Two years Degree course from a recognized University.

Or Equivalent Degree as per CBSE Norms

- (ii) A Bachelor of Education Degree or its equivalent from a college/ university recognised by Govt of India/AICTE/UGC/National Council of Teachers Education. However, B.Ed. degree is not mandatory for the post of PGT (Computers) , PGT (Physical Education) and Health Wellness Teacher (Qualification of HWT is laid down in Para 6 below).
- (iii) Should be in the age group of 21 to 50 years as on 01 July of the academic year in which the post is being filled.
- (iv) Women candidates and physically challenged candidates will be given age relaxation upto a maximum of five years.
- (v) Ex-servicemen candidates who have put in not less than six months of continuous service in the Army, Navy or the Air Force shall be allowed to deduct the period of such service from their actual age and if the resultant age does not exceed the maximum age limit prescribed for the post by more than three years, they shall be deemed to have satisfied the condition regarding age limit. Such ex-servicemen candidates, if selected for the post, will also retire from the School as per rules of the Society.
- (vi) Candidates with at least two years continuous service as a PGT/TGT or three years as a PRT/NTT in any Air Force School but presently not working in an Air Force School will be given age relaxation up to the extent of such service rendered in Air Force School.
- (vii) Should be able to read, write and communicate fluently in English (except PGT Hindi).

(i) CTET/STET qualified candidates will be given additional weightage during selection.

2. Trained Graduate Teachers

(a) Mandatory Qualifications

(i) A Masters or a Bachelor's Degree from any University recognised by the Govt of India/ UGC/ AICTE with a minimum marks of 50 percent in the subject and 50 percent in the aggregate, including electives and languages, in the combination of subjects as under :-

TGT (Science) : Botany, Zoology and Chemistry (All three subjects should have been studied)

TGT (Hindi) : Hindi as an elective subject at Degree level

TGT (Drawing) : Diploma in Drawing and Painting/
Sculpture/ Graphic Art from any Govt recognised institution

OR

Four years' Diploma in Fine Arts and Crafts from Viswa Bharati, Shanti Niketan

OR

Diploma in Fine Arts from Govt. School of Arts and Crafts, Patna

OR

M.A. in Drawing and Painting from Agra University, Agra

OR

Degree/ Diploma in Fine Arts from Regional Colleges of Education

(ii) A Bachelor of Education Degree or its equivalent from a college/ university recognised by Govt of India/AICTE/UGC/National Council of Teachers Education. However, B.Ed. degree is not mandatory for the post of TGT (Computers), TGT (Music), TGT (Games), TGT (Drawing) and Health Wellness Teacher.

(iii) Should be in the age group of 21 to 50 years as on 01 July of the academic year in which the post is being filled.

(iv) Women candidates and physically challenged candidates will be given age relaxation upto a maximum of five years.

(v) Ex-servicemen candidates who have put in not less than six months of continuous service in the Army, Navy or the Air Force shall be allowed to deduct the period of such service from their actual age and if the resultant age does not exceed the maximum age limit prescribed for the post by more than three years, they shall be deemed to have satisfied the condition regarding age limit. Such ex-servicemen candidates, if selected for the post, will also retire from the School as per rules of the Society.

(vi) Candidates with at least two years continuous service as a PGT/TGT or three years as a PRT/NTT in any Air Force School but presently not working in an Air Force School, will be given age relaxation upto the extent of such service rendered in Air Force School.

(vii) Should be able to read, write and communicate fluently in English (except TGT Hindi, Sanskrit, Games and Drawing).

(b) Desirable Qualifications (Due weightage to be given during selection)

(i) Knowledge of computer applications, especially MS Office.

(ii) Ability to read/write/communicate in Hindi.

(iii) CTET/STET qualified candidates will be given additional weightage during selection.
